

As we approach May, there is a lot of uncertainty in the world. Virus related stories dominate the news and gives everyone pause for concern. However, in contrast to the dire numbers being broadcasted every day, this situation has also brought out a spirit of compassion and togetherness in many people.

Since 4C was formed five years ago, our members have been very active at demonstrating their compassionate spirit. For example, the Grand Lake Corvette Show is held annually by a sister Corvette



club who makes sure that all proceeds go to local mountain community charities. 4C has always strongly supported that show and, over the past 4-5 years, has been the single largest group of participants with many of our members purchasing raffles and donating food items or toiletries to help make even a bigger impact.

Aside from supporting other club events whose proceeds go to charities, **4C** has also been **very generous** regarding donations given directly to charitable organizations. Two organizations that 4C has strongly supported through the years are 9Cares Colorado Shares and Toys for Tots. Other beneficiaries of 4C's charity also include the American Cancer Society, The Fisher House, and the Crisis Center.

While car shows, drives, cars and coffee events, club dinners, and the like have recently fallen victim to Coronavirus related closures, **4C** is "turning lemons into lemonade". One of our Board members, Barry Hawkins, with his plans for organizing a fun Corvette cruise for members thwarted by the State of Colorado Stay at Home order, instead came up with an alternative plan. His idea was to ask club members to donate to a local charity all of which are feeling the burden of increased demand and diminished donations due to the current economic conditions.

After doing an on-line poll of membership to obtain the necessary approval, **the club is moving forward with a matching donation** (up to a pre-determined limit) that will be combined with member contributions to be given **to the Denver Rescue Mission**. We are calling this endeavor, "Instead of a Fun Drive, How About a Fund Drive."

This action speaks again to the generosity of **our members and their willingness to contribute positively and substantially to our community**. While Corvettes brought all of us together, and despite being "inconvenienced" by having to pause our Corvette themed recreational activities as usual, we have found a familiar way of doing something to help others in a time of great need.

I wish to personally thank everyone in the club who has chosen to contribute to this cause. I am also proud to be part of an organization that does meaningful things and more than just "car stuff". Take care and stay healthy.





COVER PAGE: There have been 16 Corvettes named as the Pace Car for the Indianapolis 500 and a total of 30 Chevrolets. This 500-mile race is currently the world's oldest operational automobile race. Better known as the Indy 500, it is held annually at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway in Speedway, Indiana, an enclave suburb of Indianapolis, Indiana. Due to the coronavirus, the event has been rescheduled for **August 23rd**.



The Chevrolet brothers were early race car drivers. **Louis Chevrolet** drove in the Indianapolis 500 four times, with a best finish of 7th in 1919. **Arthur Chevrolet** competed twice, and **Gaston Chevrolet** won the race in 1920.

MUSEUM STATUS DURING PANDEMIC

Early in 2020, the NCM announced its full schedule of on-site events for the year. Since then the NCM's status changed due to the virus pandemic. Consequently, I will be updating Museum events and activities as I receive information, and the following information reflects current scheduling.

Michelin Bash: On March 16th, NCM announced the Michelin Bash has been rescheduled to May 28-30, 2020. If you have already registered and will attend May 28-30, you don't have to do anything, as registration and other fees will be transferred to the rescheduled event. If you cannot attend, you have until May 7th to cancel and get a full refund. The NCM recommends that you log into your account (you should have one if you registered) and cancel. You can also call or e-mail NCM to cancel. I will keep you informed of any further changes. **ONE MORE THING** - don't forget to change your hotel reservations!

Vettecademy: An online educational program for children (and interested adults) was recently developed. Online Car Show: The Museum is hosting an online car show. Entries were opened April 6th-12th, and winners will be announced April 23rd with an online video. Because this was a "Fun Celebrity Choice Show," there were no set criteria for the show.



Harley Earl of GM selected the Jaguar 120 as the benchmark for the new Corvette. General Motors purchased at least one XK 120 to closely study its design and construction. A sports car like the 120 had never been built by GM, who was the largest car manufacturer in the world at that time. When the two cars are compared there are obvious similarities. One of the main characteristics of the Jaguar is the passion it inspired amongst its followers. Harley Earl wanted to capture that concept.
